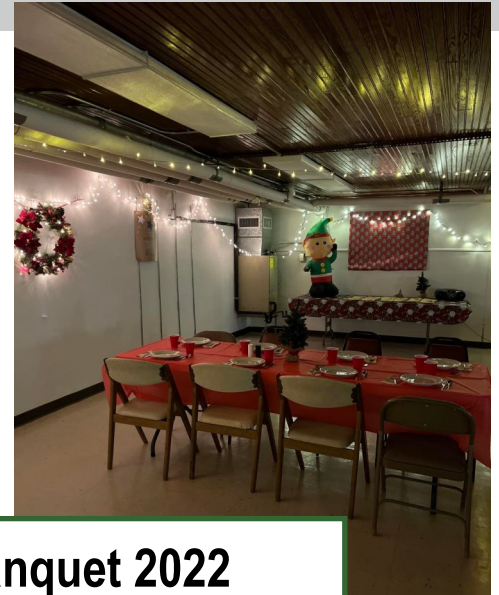
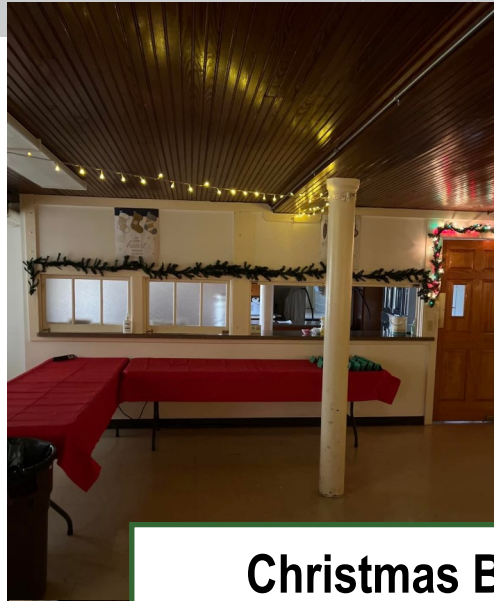

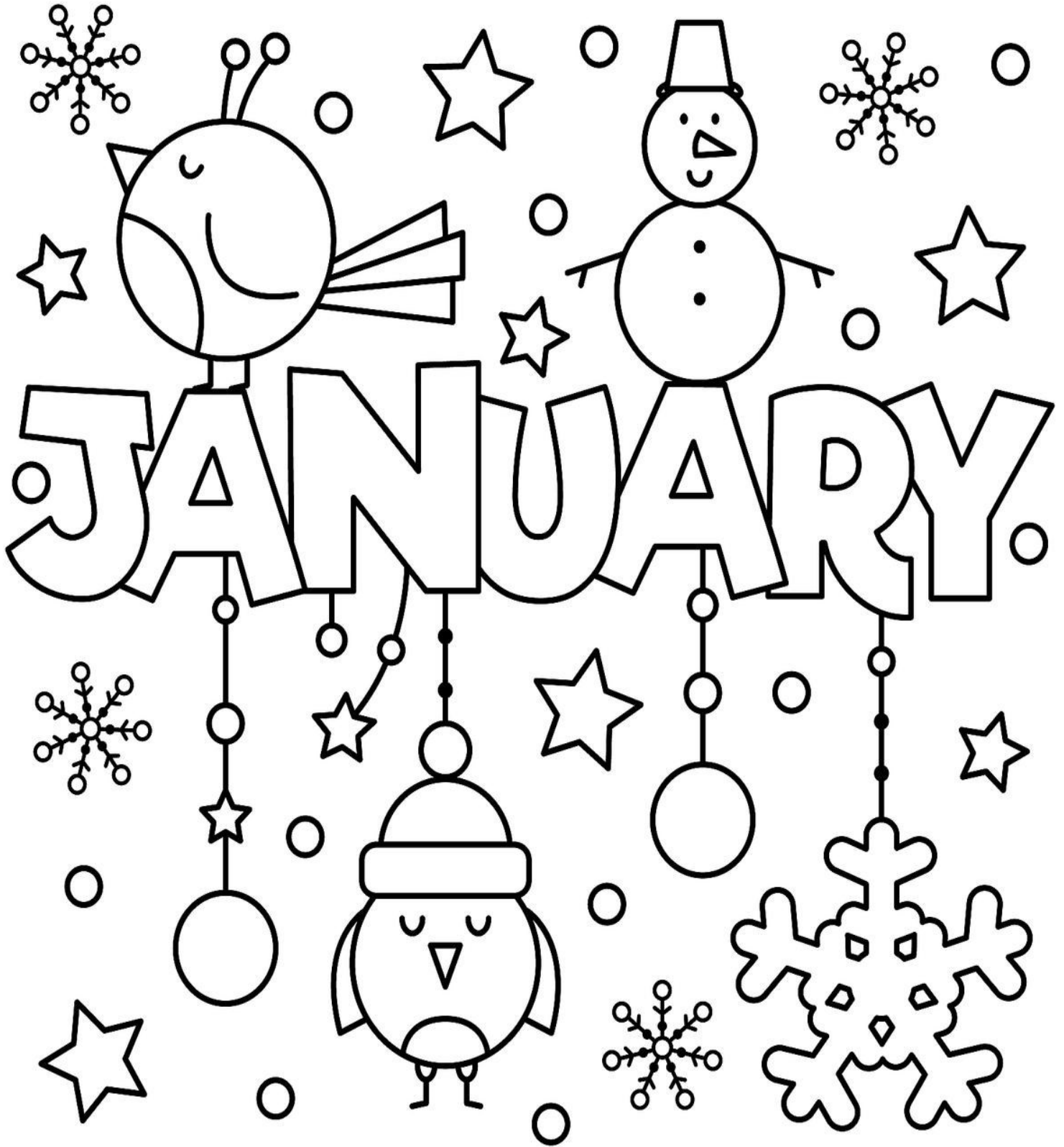
FROM UNITED FELLOWSHIP...

Thank you to all who bought gifts for the Children of Bethany. We received all the gifts we requested and more! The gifts were delivered and very much appreciated.



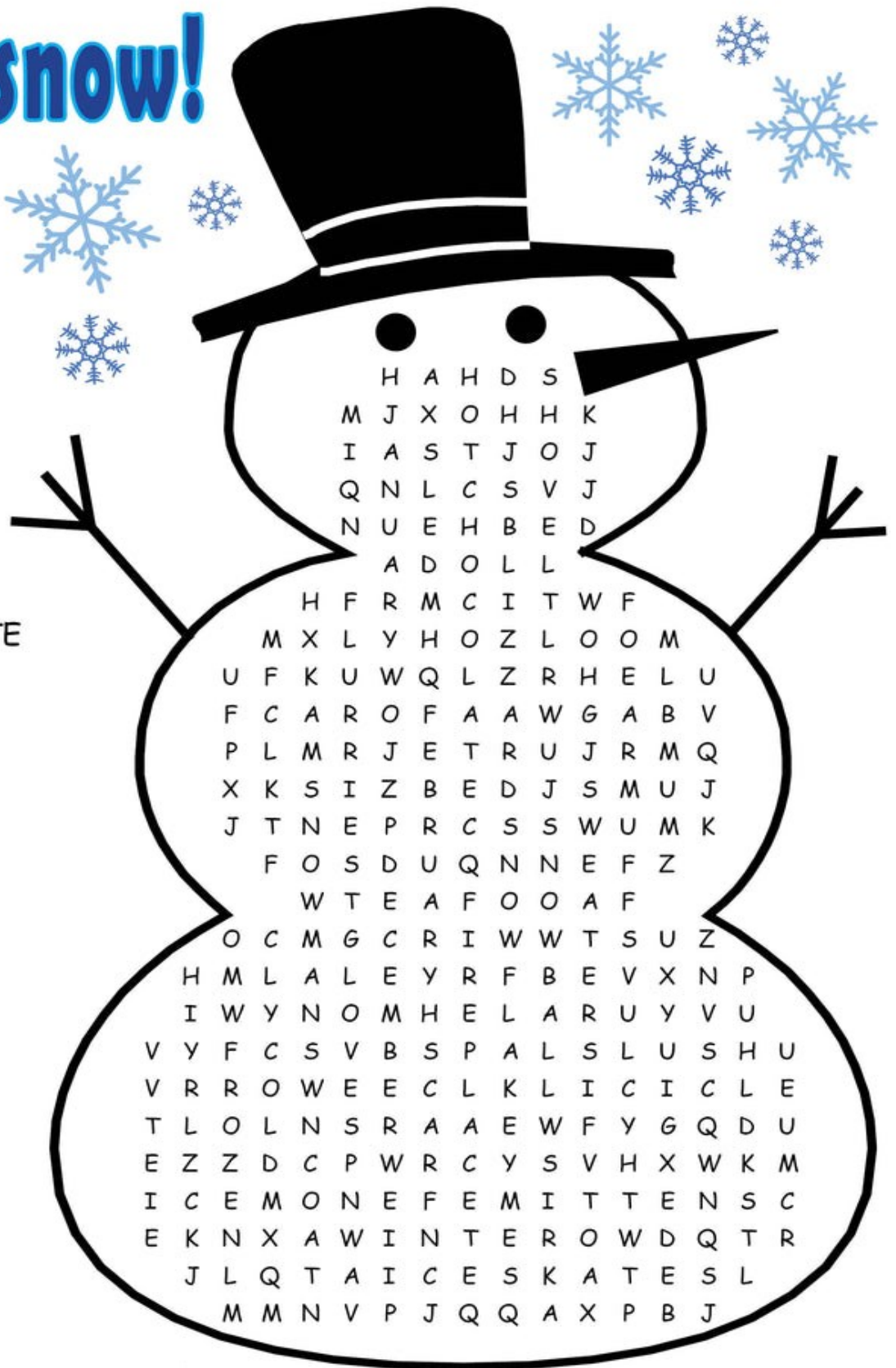
